

What is Sculptra?

Sculptra is a non-invasive injectable used to provide fullness and volume to the face. It is a type of dermal filler that is designed to stimulate the production of collagen in your face. Sculptra is made of poly-Llactic

acid which is an FDA-approved biocompatible substance. It is naturally absorbed by the body and has been safely used for decades.

Sculptra is best used if you are looking for natural, gradual results. Sculptra is designed to reverse the signs of aging in the face by aiding in the creation of new collagen. The creation of new collagen does not happen overnight, which is why you will see gradual results.

Why Sculptra?

Sculptra is different from other dermal fillers such as Juvederm, Radiesse and Restylane. The main difference is in the fact that Sculptra provides results over time. The other dermal fillers provide more instant results but also do not last as long as Sculptra does. Sculptra can be used in conjunction with other dermal fillers in order to achieve the best results.

appearance, Sculptra may be right for you. It will refill the volume in the contours of the face and leave you with a younger-looking, refreshed glow!

Sculptra can also treat sagging skin on the décolleté and acne scars. It treats all of these conditions by stimulating your body to produce new collagen to add volume to the area being treated. You must be in generally good health in order to receive Sculptra treatment.

Sculptra Procedure

The Sculptra procedure is relatively similar to those of other dermal



fillers. Sculptra is injected into a deeper layer of the skin in order to encourage new collagen growth. A very small needle is still used during the procedure.

Before your procedure, a topical anesthetic will be applied to the treatment area a half an hour before the injections begin. The Sculptra formula includes Lidocaine to ease any discomfort as it is being injected.

Every patient is different so
Roseville Facial Plastic Surgery will
use their extensive knowledge to let
you know how many treatment
sessions and dosage of Sculptra you
may need. The average number of
sessions usually needed to see the
best results is three. These treatment
sessions are spaced out about six
weeks apart.

Sculptra Recovery

There is minimal to no downtime after receiving Sculptra treatment. You may return to your normal activities after the procedure, but should take it easy for the first 24 hours. Some common side effects include minor swelling and bruising for the first few days. After the procedure is complete, ice packs are placed on the treatment area to reduce swelling and bruising. It is recommended to continue the use of ice packs for the first 24 hours to minimize side effects.

After the treatment you must follow the "5-5-5" regimen. For five days following your treatment, you must massage the treatment area five times a day for five minutes each. This helps make sure the Sculptra is being distributed evenly.

Sculptra Results

Immediately following treatment, you may see noticeable results in increased facial volume because of the amount of Sculptra that was injected. This will decrease over the next couple days since Sculptra is designed to produce gradual, long-lasting results. You will begin to see the improvement over the next four to six weeks. Most patients continue seeing great results two years after treatment and are satisfied with their results.
